## TREASURER'S REPORT - Emily:

**BC Gaming Grant** – up 20% from last year, \$24 per child, \$7632 dollars. Previously used toward iPads, water fountains, picnic tables, etc. Has to be used to benefit students and must report to Gaming Commission

Welcome BBQ - \$398 profit thanks to generous donations

Outstanding Approved Items - Coupon books \$1600 - have made more than last year - \$3300 in total sales with 1/2 to the PAC

## **PRINCIPAL'S REPORT:**

Four student teachers this term, two in K, Mrs Baker's class and Mrs. Paul's class. All in their last session and will graduate soon. Posting out for additional EA now.

Big thank you for all the help with the book fair. Approx. \$3700 in books sold, resulted in Ms. Bergen being able to spend over \$1500 on new books for the library.

Grade 4 in midst of writing FSA's (foundation skills assessment – all Gr 4's in BC participate, tests all skills to end of Gr 3).

Grade 5's participating in DARE program. Added benefit of having a marked police vehicle in the parking lot to slow down traffic! Cst CHRISTENSEN will be in the school once a week for 10 weeks.

## Presentation: Rationale for Reporting without Letter Grades in Gr 4 &5

Why? -2017 survey to parents on how to increase engagement

Gr 4 &5 letter grades have not been based on percentages for past 15 years.

Concerns – letter grades may/may not align with new curriculum

- Parents want context
- Parents want info on social & emotional growth

Many other districts no longer use letter grades (Surrey, Vancouver, Comox, Abbotsford, Coquitlam, Maple Ridge, etc)

Goal: parents well informed

Parents are partners in progress

Redesigned curriculum reflects a continuous learning model which letter grades may hinder with.

However, if a parents feels strongly they can request a letter grade from the teacher.

Now Using: Beginning, Developing, Applying, Extending

Also will be presenting information cross-curricular (ex. Language skills embedded in science lesson).
