We are very fortunate to have the opportunity to welcome a team from St. John Ambulance Therapy Dogs. "Buck" and his handler Julie will be coming into the school to visit students and classrooms starting next week on Tuesday on an ongoing basis. If you do not want your child to participate in this program, please reach out to Mr. Chater to excuse your child.

The therapy dogs go through intensive testing before being certified to work with people. Buck currently works in Fraser Health hospitals, senior centers and the University of the Fraser Valley. We are excited to welcome them next week.

Inside Days:

When it is necessary to have an inside day, students will go to their classroom in the morning. Portables will be open and if students are inside the school, the East Door (close to the Gaga Ball Pit) will be open for students to enter the building.

Thank you to our PAC for organizing and supplying all the food for our BBQ. We appreciate all you do for our school community!

School Supplies:

We received some good news regarding our school supplies. We will be able to continue to offer the purchase service from previous years. You are now able to start sending the \$60 fee for school supplies to your child's teacher and teachers have ordered the supplies for the students.

Our planners didn't fair so well in the warehouse fire and were lost. The company is reprinting them for us and they will be made available to us in about 6 weeks. The \$60 for school supplies includes the purchase of the planner.

Parking Lot:

The parking lot is incredibly busy with buses, students and cars. If you drop off or pick up your child, please familiarize yourself with how the parking lot works. There is no exiting or leaving your vehicle unattended in any of the lanes. This stops the flow in the parking lot and paralyzes it. We need your cooperation to keep this a safe place.

All traffic is one way moving from the west to the east.

There are 3 lanes in the parking lot, the lane closest to the school is for Busses Only (Lane #1). (Unless directed to use it by staff)

Lane 2 is the Drop Off Lane - Drivers may not get out of your vehicle or leave it in any lane unattended.

Lane 3 is a Drive-Thru Lane - there is no stopping in this lane either. There are times before school when staff will start to direct vehicles into this lane if traffic is backing up on the road. Please remind your child to look both ways before crossing the parking lot.

After school you may wait in your vehicle in lane #2 and #3 prior to the bell so we don't back onto the road but please do not leave your vehicle unattended in the lanes.

And finally, please be patient and allow others to merge in and out of the parking lot. ECE has very few spots for parking, and as our school grows your patience and cooperation will make a difference in the mornings and after school. We all want our kids to be safe.
