Long distance running is back for its yearly finale for Grades 1-5 students! Practices will be on


Tuesdays and Thursdays at recess time. The race will be on **Thursday, May 1st** at Cultus Lake Elementary. Parents/Guardians need to be

present while their child is racing. The race starts at 3:30 with grade 1 girls, then grade 1 boys start when the grade 1 girls return, etc. The race will be 1.1km for grade 1-4, and 1.4km for grade 5's.

More details will be given on the permission slips, which will be handed out closer to the race day. There will be free parking at Lot B (by Adventure Park) and the Waterslides. The race starts at 3:30, and is usually done by 5.
