**Cross-Country Race for Grades 1-5!** 


Long distance running is back for its yearly finale for Grades 1-5 students! Practices will be on Tuesdays and Thursdays at recess time.

The race starts at 3:30 with grade 1 girls, then grade 1 boys start when the grade 1 girls return, etc. The race will be 1.1km for grade 1-4, and 1.4km for grade 5's.


