Parking Lot and Pick Up



We have a small, one-way parking lot. Drop off and pickup time is extremely busy. Student safety is our prime concern. If you are making the choice to pick up or drop off, please be mindful of student safety. Watch for students crossing the parking lot, exercise patience, and expect it to be congested.

A couple of guidelines will help keep the parking lot moving:

- The drive through lanes in the middle of the parking lot are for pickup/drop off only. Do not leave your car unattended in these lanes. If you need to leave your vehicle, please park in a perimeter parking stall.
 - · We have three lanes in the parking lot:
 - a. Lane 1 is closest to the school and is the bus lane.
 - b. Lane 2 is the Pickup and Drop-off Lane.
- c. Lane 3 is the Thru lane. In the morning when traffic is at its busiest, staff may direct you into the through lane (lane 3) to drop off. We do this so that traffic doesn't back out onto the road.

 Remind your child each day before they exit your vehicle to look both ways before crossing to the school
- d. At dismissal time, parents can park their vehicles in the dedicated parking spots on the east side of the parking lot by our school street sign (back in only) or in both the pickup/drop-off lane and the thru lane (but not leave your vehicle). We do this once again so that traffic doesn't back out onto the road.
- At dismissal time, please make sure you are not blocking our entrance to the parking lot. We must fit 4-5 busses into the parking lot, and they need a wide area to turn into the parking lot. They will honk their horns to have you move if you're blocking access.
