Parking Lot and Pick Up



We have a small, one-way parking lot. Drop-off and pickup times are extremely busy.

Student safety is our prime concern. Watch for students crossing the parking lot, exercise patience, and expect it to be congested.

- The drive-through lanes in the middle of the parking lot are for pickup/drop off only.

 Do not leave your car unattended in these lanes. If you need to leave your vehicle, please park in a perimeter parking stall.
 - We have three lanes in the parking lot:
 - a. Lane 1 is closest to the school and is the bus lane.
 - b. Lane 2 is the Pickup and Drop-off Lane.
- c. Lane 3 is the Thru lane. Remind your child each day before they exit your vehicle to look both ways before crossing to the school.
- d. At dismissal time, parents can park their vehicles in the dedicated parking spots on the east side of the parking lot by our school street sign (back in only please wait until the buses leave at 2:09) or use the pick up lanes (do not leave your vehicle unattended).
- At dismissal time, please ensure you are not blocking our entrance to the parking lot.

 We must fit 4-5 buses into the parking lot, and they need a wide area to turn into the parking lot. They will honk their horns to have you move.

If you arrive at 2:10, our first buses have left, and our parking lot is not busy. This is a great time to pick up your child. We have supervision until our last bus picks up at 2:20.
