INLINE SKATING *Grade 2-5*

Dear Parents,

Our school has reserved an inline skating kit to use in Grade 2-5 PHE classes from Tuesday, May 11th to Thursday, May 21st. All skating will be done in the gymnasium. This resource comes with everything needed to enjoy this awesome activity:

- Adjustable youth inline skates (sizes 2-5 & 5-8) + adult sizes 10 & 12
- Protective equipment (wrist guards, elbow pads, knee pads)
- Helmets
 - It is RECOMMENDED that students bring a helmet from home.
 - There are spare helmets in the kit, but to ensure correct sizing, a properly fitted helmet from home is the best option.
 - While skating, helmets must be worn at all times.

If your child has inline skates at home, these can be brought to school and used provided they are in good working order. Students will be taught how to get to a standing position, balance, the basic stride, turning, and stopping.

It will help get students ready more quickly if your child knows their shoe size.
