"Our thoughts and prayers continue to go out to all the victims, their families and classmates who were affected by the electrical incident which occurred June 15, 2026. Technical Safety BC is actively investigating the incident and their findings will be reported. We are fully cooperating with all authorities as they complete this process. This incident was tragic and we are deeply upset by what these children experienced at our park.

At this time, we do not know the full scope of work, and cannot confirm a specific reopening date. Because of this we have made the unfortunate decision to cancel all remaining school bookings for June.

Thank you for your patience, we will be issuing you a refund for your field trip within the following week. We understand this is an outing you and your students look forward to all year and recognize the coordination and planning involved. We are deeply sorry, we apologize for the inconvenience and appreciate the understanding. It is important for us to be sure to provide a safe environment."
