Parking Lot Procedures and Safety



Our parking lot is small and one-way, and drop-off and pick-up times can be **very busy**. Student safety is our top priority. Please watch for students, exercise patience, and expect congestion during peak times.

To help keep traffic moving safely:

- The centre lanes are for active pick-up and drop-off only. Please **do not leave your vehicle unattended**. If you need to exit your vehicle, use a designated parking stall.
- Lane 1: Bus Lane (closest to the school)
- Lane 2: Pick-Up and Drop-Off Lane
- Lane 3: Through Lane

During busy morning drop-off times, staff may direct vehicles into Lane 3 to help prevent traffic from backing up onto the road. Please remind your child to look both ways before crossing the parking lot. Morning supervision begins at 7:30. Please do not drop your child off before 7:30 am.

At dismissal, parents may park in the designated stalls on the east side of the parking lot (back-in parking only) or use Lanes 2 and 3 for active pick-up. If using Lanes 2 or 3, please remain in your vehicle. If you pick up at 2:10, this is a great time to pick up your child as all of the first buses have departed. We have supervision until 2:20.

Please **do not block the parking lot entrance** at dismissal. We need enough space for 5 buses to enter and maneuver safely.

Thank you for helping us keep our parking lot safe and efficient for everyone.
